JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 96, dated 28.05.2010, under Sections 457, 380 and 411 IPC, registered at Police Station City Malerkotla (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise dated 02.03.2015 (Annexure P-2).

2. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise is voluntary, without any pressure or coercion. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 96, dated 28.05.2010, under Sections 457, 380 and 411 IPC, registered at Police Station City Malerkotla and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua petitioner.
