This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Tripri Town, District Patiala, vide FIR No.496 dated 10.11.2013.
