RAJ MOHAN SINGH J. (ORAL)

On 12.03.2015, this Court passed the following order;

“Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the occurrence is alleged to have taken place on 21.02.2011 and, thereafter, a compromise was recorded on 03.03.2011. The FIR ultimately came to be recorded at a belated stage i.e. on 18.03.2011. During the course of investigation, petitioners were found innocent, however, they have been summoned with the aid of Section 319 Cr.P.C. Learned counsel relies upon the statement of the complainant has tried to improve the original version and even if the statement of the complainant is taken to be on its face value, the petitioners have no incriminating role in the entire episode.”

Notice of motion for 23.04.2015.

Petitioners are directed to appear before the trial Court on or before 24.03.2015. In the event of their appearance before the trial Court, trial Court shall admit the petitioners on interim bail subject to its satisfaction.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in pursuance to aforesaid order, petitioners have appeared before the trial Court and have been granted interim bail on 24.03.2015.

Learned counsel for the complainant, however, vehemently opposed the bail.

Looking to the number of persons viz-a-viz the part attributed to them in DDR, in FIR and the statement made by the complainant in Court, this Court considers it to be a fit case, where interim order is to be made absolute.

Ordered accordingly.
