Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.02 dated 21.01.2014, registered at Police Station State Crime SAS Nagar, Mohali, District Mohali, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 16.05.2014, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the

satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

Vide order dated 15.07.2014 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, learned State counsel was directed to place on record the work orders so as to ascertain the factum of the entire fencing work having been completed.

The said order has not been complied with till today.

On instructions from Inspector Kulwant Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 16.05.2014 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
