The petitioners, who are the family members of husband-Gurpreet Singh, have filed the present revision directed against the order dated 09.01.2013 (**Annexure P-2**), passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana, whereby they have been summoned as additional accused to face trial on an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. of the prosecution for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 498-A, 506 and 120-B, IPC, registered with Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the present revision petition has become infructuous in the light of the main FIR and all the subsequent proceedings itself having been quashed by this Court in **CRM-M No.17803 of 2015** on the basis of compromise dated 02.04.2015, arrived at between the parties, vide order of even date.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
