Instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his other family members from the hands of private respondents.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar City, to personally look into the grievance of the petitioner specifically made in representation dated 25.01.2015 (Annexure P-5) and if facts are found to be correct, then necessary protection shall be provided to the petitioner and his family

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members in accordance with law.
