PARAMJEET SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.104/2013 dated 25.08.2013 registered under Sections 324/506/34 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station E Division, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is behind bars since 29.11.2014. Case is still at the stage of prosecution evidence.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
