This petition has been moved by Jagdeep Singh under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.110 dated 18.07.2012 registered under Sections 302, 34 IPC and 25-54-59 of Arms Act at Police Station Jagraon, Ludhiana.

Notice of motion.

Mr. B.S. Bhullar, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody for the last more than two years. Co-accused Kashmir Singh was granted bail by this Court. Gurpreet Singh was the main accused who had allegedly fired a shot and killed his mother-in-law- Amarjit Kaur. His brothers Harpreet Singh and Joga Singh were found allegedly present with him but Joga Singh had been found innocent while supplementary challan has been filed against Harpreet Singh as stated. No specific role is attributed to the petitioner. It is simply alleged that he was present with Gurpreet Singh. Kashmir Singh was allegedly driving the car in which the assailants had arrived.

The case of the petitioner is almost akin to that of Kashmir Singh and no specific role has been attributed to him. He is not even specifically named in the FIR.

As per the custody certificate, the period of custody of the petitioner is 2 years 7 months and 22 days.

Six prosecution witnesses have been examined which includes the complainant as well.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Chief Judicial Magistrate.
