The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for the issuance of directions to the official respondents to take measures to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner on the pleadings that he faces an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents no. 2 to 6.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition at the initial stage itself in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent No. 2 i.e. the Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar, as regards his apprehension and threat perception. Respondent No. 2 i.e. the Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar, is directed to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and which are warranted strictly in accordance with law.
