This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 323/324/34 IPC, later on added section 326 IPC and later on added section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (which section was deleted again on 2.2.2015), at Police Station Sadar Moga, District Moga, vide DDR No.20 dated 18.7.2014 in FIR No.87 dated 22.7.2014.

Learned State counsel (on the instructions from ASI Surinderpal, who is present in court) submits that pursuant to order dated March 27, 2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated March 27, 2015 is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed in aforesaid terms.
