1. Whether Reporters of Local Newspapers may be allowed to see the judgment?

Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 02.01.2015. The photographs of the marriage have been placed on file as Annexures-P-4 and P-5. The Matriculation Certificates showing the date of birth of petitioner Nos. 1 and 2 have been placed on file as Annexures P-1 and P-2. Marriage Certificate has been placed on file as Annexure P-3.

It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an application dated 02.01.2015 (Annexure-P-6) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life and liberty from the private respondents.

In these circumstances, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, to consider the application of the petitioners dated 02.01.2015 (Annexure-P-6) and assess the threat perception attributed to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is a danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be taken to be the proof of valid marriage.

Disposed of accordingly.
