FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.125 dated 17.2.2015 under Sections 406, 420 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines Hisar, District Hisar.

The allegations in this anticipatory bail application against the petitioner are that she on false representation through deceit has sold one plot situated in Gurgaon to the complainant and in the process has received a sum of ₹15,00,000/-.

At the very onset, learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner has paid back ₹15,00,000/- to the complainant and which fact has been duly

conceded to at the bar by the learned counsel for the complainant as well as by learned State counsel. More so, the evidence is based on the documentary record which is available in the public office and nothing is to be recovered from her.

Keeping in view the same, being a lady and that some sort of compromise has been effected between the parties, the present petition seeking anticipatory bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Investigating Officer and that she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
