Report dated 10.11.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Fatehgarh Sahib has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Ranjit Singh and Baljit Singh as well as of complainant Amarjit Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052,** Complaint No.62-T dated 13.11.2009/12 under Sections 452, 323,434,506,34 IPC, Police Station, Mulepur, District Fatehgarh Sahib and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby

quashed qua the present petitioners.
