This petition has been preferred under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure by Sukhwinder Singh @ Laddu (now confined in Central Jail, Jalandhar) seeking bail, during the pendency of the trial in case bearing FIR No.60 dated 01.06.2012, under Sections 21, 25, 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 read with Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar.

It is an undisputed fact that no recovery of any incriminating article was effected from the possession of petitioner and further that his co-accused namely Harjinder Singh @ Rajinder Singh, Amandeep Singh @ Cheema, Sukhwinder Singh @ Sukha, Ruk Bahadur, Gurinder Singh and Sukhjinder Singh @ Jinder @ Comando have already been granted the concession of regular bail vide various judgments orders passed by the Coordinate Bench of

this Court in CRM-M-17768 of 2014 dated 30.05.2014, CRM-M-18304 of 2014 dated 30.05.2014, CRM-M-11719 of 2014 dated 22.04.2014, CRM-M-20425 of 2014 dated 20.06.2014, CRM-M-9826 of 2014 dated 09.04.2014 and CRM-M-14049 of 2013 dated 01.07.2013, respectively.

The case of the petitioner is not on different footings than that of the above named persons. Moreover, the disposal of the trial is likely to take sufficient long time. In the given circumstances, incarceration of the petitioner would be absolutely unwarranted.

Accordingly, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail at the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar.
