As per pleadings on record, the present petitioner got married with Subhash i.e. respondent No. 4, nine years back and out of wedlock, 3 children were born. Assertions made in the petition are that she has been harassed and maltreated by her husband and in-laws and circumstances were created which left her with no other option but to seek shelter outside the matrimonial home. Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is currently residing with a person, namely, Rajesh at Village Ratta Khera, District Sirsa.

Allegations raised in the instant petition are that respondents No. 4 and 5 i.e. husband and brother-in-law in connivance with the local police officials are threatening her and forcing her to return back to her matrimonial home against her wishes. Counsel submits that the petitioner apprehends a threat to her life.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition at the very initial stage with liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No. 2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Sirsa as

regards her grievance. In the eventuality of her doing so, respondent No. 2 i.e. Superintendent of Police Sirsa would look into the matter and thereafter would take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted strictly in accordance with law.
