This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioners under Sections 307, 325, 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on) at Police Station Dakha, District Judhiana, vide FIR No.161 dated 26.7.2013.
