This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case in which petitioner has been summoned under Section 506 IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the trial court for regular bail. He, however, prays that some protection may be afforded to the petitioner in order to enable him to avail the remedy.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid. In case petitioner prefers an application for regular bail before the trial court within ten days from today, his plea shall be decided within a week thereafter. His arrest shall remain stayed till decision of his bail application.
