Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.148 dated 30.8.2014 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on) at Police Station Sunam, District Sangrur.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 13.3.2015 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation. Recovery has already been effected and he is no more required for the purpose of any further investigation. He prays for allowing the present petition.
