Petitioners seek quashing of an FIR under Sections 306/34 IPC, registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Kesar Singh alleging that petitioners are responsible for the suicide committed by his daughter, who was found dead at her in-laws house.

I do not find any ground to permit quashing on the basis of compromise by the family members of the girl.

At this stage, counsel for petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

This order will not in any manner prejudice the right of the petitioners to seek acquittal in accordance with law.
