The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 21 dated 08.02.2015, under Section 409 IPC, registered at Police Station Kulgari, District Ferozepur.

Counsel for the petitioner would, vehemently, argue that the petitioner is working as a Secretary in the Changali Khatrian Multipurpose Co-operative Agriculture Service Society Ltd. and has been falsely implicated only on account of party factionalism.

Be that as it may, the allegations are that a Member of the Co-operative Society, namely, Balvir Singh (since deceased) had taken a loan, principal amount of ₹87,413/- in the year 2007. The present petitioner is alleged to have issued a 'No Objection Certificate' after having received an amount of ₹87,413/- from the legal heir (of deceased Balvir Singh), namely, Naginder Pal Singh and interest amount of ₹53,137/- and had issued a 'No Objection Certificate' and such amount has not been credited in the accounts of the concerned Co-operative Society. Such allegations have been specifically noticed in the impugned order dated 24.02.2015 passed by the Additional

Sessions Judge, Ferozepur while declining the prayer seeking anticipatory bail. Even the recovery of such amount is yet to be effected.

This Court does not find any infirmity in the order passed by the Court below by declining the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition dismissed.
