ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.7 dated 19.01.2015, registered under Section 420 IPC, Police Station Payal, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana.

The allegations made by the complainant are that the petitioner got half share of the land transferred in his own name against the wishes of the complainant and by playing fraud. The allegations further are that there was a loan outstanding and the petitioner had withdrawn the amount from the account and had used it up instead of repaying the loan. Allegations have also been made

by the complainant that the petitioner had got the tractor transferred in his own name.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no fraud had been played and it is a change of heart and the matter is civil in nature and custodial interrogation is required.

The complainant side had appeared on last date of hearing and as it is a dispute between the father and son, the parties were asked to seek instructions if the matter could be settled. Respondent no.2 who is 84 years old has appeared in the Court. His counsel states that they are ready for the compromise if the land is returned. Counsel for the petitioner states that there are no chances of settlement.

Heard.

The complainant has levelled allegations against his own son of cheating and transferring his property. He has also made allegations that a sum of Rs.3 lacs was withdrawn from his account and used by him. Custodial interrogation is necessary. Recovery is to be effected. No case for anticipatory bail is made out. The petition is dismissed.
