The prayer in this petition is for seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 5 to register an FIR against accused No.6, responsible for commission of serious offences including offences of rape, molestation, kissing etc.

In response to notice of motion issued on 13.01.2014, learned State counsel has filed reply which is already on record. Learned State counsel submits that the present petition has become infructuous as notice was issued to the complainant and the cancellation report was prepared and submitted before the Court after lodging of the FIR.

In view of the submission made by learned State counsel and after seeing the prayer in the present petition, no ground is made out to interfere at this stage as the prayer is only for lodging of FIR which has already been lodged and cancellation report has also been submitted before the Court. Therefore, the present petition is hereby dismissed.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to raise all his pleas before the trial Court.
