Ruby @ Salma and Sikander Kumar, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No. 4 to 9 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents no. 4 to 9. They have placed on record marriage certificate and photographs, Annexures P-4 and P-5 respectively.

Petitioner No.1 has not mentioned about any conversion. Petitioner No.1 is a Muslim and petitioner no.2 is a Hindu. There cannot be a valid marriage between the parties.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel contends that the petitioners shall again approach the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar-respondent No.2 for redressal of their grievance and protection. He requests for withdrawal of the instant petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid. If any representation is made, respondent no.2 shall consider the same and take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law
