The case of the petitioners is that they are major and have contracted marriage on March 09, 2015. The marriage certificate and the photographs evidencing marriage have been placed on file. It is alleged that they apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 10. To seek redressal of their grievance, they have submitted representation dated 09.03.2015 (Annexure P-4) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur.

Notice to respondents No.1 to 3, only at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Mr. J.S. Sekhon, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the age of the petitioners and validity of the marriage, directions are given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, to decide the representation of the petitioners (Annexure P-4) within one month from today, keeping in view the threat perception to the petitioners.

However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.

The petition stands disposed of.
