JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 296 dated October 22, 2013 under Sections 323, 341, 365 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, Jalandhar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated February 16, 2015 (Annexure P-2).

2 Report of learned trial Court has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that the matter has been compromised between the parties without any pressure, coercion and the same appears to be genuine. Even otherwise, matter involved in these proceedings is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. So, in view of circumstances narrated above as well as the observations made in case reported as ***Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another; 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052***, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for the benefit of the parties and would certainly bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 296 dated October 22, 2013 under Sections 323, 341, 365 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, Jalandhar and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same are quashed qua the petitioners.
