The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner, who faces a threat to the same at the hands of private respondents no.5 to 9.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same at the initial stage itself in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent no.3 i.e. S.S.P., Tarn Taran as regards her grievance. In the eventuality of petitioner moving any representation, respondent no.3 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted strictly in accordance with law.
