This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioners under Sections 354, 323 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka, vide FIR No.13 dated 23.2.2015.

Learned State counsel submits that pursuant to order dated March 17, 2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.
