MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for appropriate directions to the official respondents to register a case against respondents No.5 to 8 on the basis of complaint initiated by the petitioner in the year 2011. The facts would indicate an inquiry into this complaint and a report by the SHO in the year 2011 itself. Also indicated is a fact of civil suit pending inter se between the parties. In this view of the matter, when the report is of the year 2011 and more than three years have elapsed, I would not deem it appropriate to issue any direction as prayed for. The petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail of any other remedy that he may choose including the one available to him under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C.
