Heard. State counsel submits that he has already received copy of the petition.

The first date fixed for prosecution evidence was 09.07.2014. Between the said date and 26.02.2015, more than twelve opportunities for evidence were availed by the prosecution and only one formal witness was examined. The custody of the under-trial is being prolonged due to the lapse on the part of the prosecution in not conducting the evidence. It is also not understandable as to why Trial Court has granted so many adjournments without even specifying the last opportunity would be granted to the prosecution to bring its entire evidence on the last date, which was 13.03.2015.

In view of the above, the petitioner is allowed to bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/CJM concerned.
