The petitioner alleges false implication in case F.I.R No.11 dated 2.2.2015 registered under sections 22, 61 and 85 of N.D.P.S Act registered at Police Station, Adampur.

It has been contended by the counsel that the petitioner has been involved falsely at the behest of respondents no.5 and 6.

Without even ascertaining and going into the veracity of such assertion, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to respondent no.3 i.e. S.S.P., Jalandhar (Rural) to look into the allegations made by the petitioner in the light of a representation dated 3.2.2015 (Annexure P-4), which is stated to have been already filed by the wife of the petitioner. Respondent no.3 would be obligated to verify the contents of Annexure P-4 and thereafter would be at liberty to take all such steps as he may deem fit and as warranted strictly in accordance with law.
