Reply by way of affidavit dated 5.5.2015 filed in the Court today is taken on record and copy thereof has been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Premjit Singh, Police Station, Bhogpur, District Jalandhar, submits that there is no case registered against the petitioners nor they are required in any other case for the purpose of investigation. He further submits that as and when petitioners would be required in any other case for the purpose of investigation, they will be proceeded, strictly in accordance with law. If they are prima facie needed, an appropriate notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. shall be issued to the petitioners, if so required. Learned counsel for the State, however, submits that Pardeep son of petitioner No.1 is an accused in FIR No. 4 dated 8.1.2015 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Bhogpur. He is still at large.

In view of the above statement made by the learned counsel for the State, it is made clear that so far as FIR No.4 dated 8.1.2015 is concerned, investigating agency will have every right to investigate the matter, in accordance with law.

With the above-said observations made, present petition stands disposed of.
