JASPAL SINGH, J.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 50, dated 29.10.2014, under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Woman Police Station, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1) and subsequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise appears to be genuine, voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence. Even otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

In view of the above, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

Consequently, the instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 50, dated 29.10.2014, under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Woman Police Station, District Bathinda and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner.
