The petitioner is a complainant in FIR No.360 dated 30.11.2014, under Sections 395, 329, 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

In the said FIR, the petitioner had leveled allegations that his brother's son Varinder Singh wanted to go abroad and in this regard they had contacted Wajir Singh @ Rana. At his instance, the passports of Varinder Singh and others were handed over to accused Wazir Singh, who had called the petitioner and his nephew Ranjit Singh along with three other persons to Delhi. It is further claimed in the FIR that Harvinder Singh and 2-3 other persons had taken away their car after giving beatings to Baldev Singh and Sukhdev Singh.

Being dissatisfied with the investigation being not fair, the present petition has been filed.

On notice having been issued to the State, a reply has been filed by Superintendent of Police, Derabassi, District SAS Nagar, Mohali specifying that accused Wazir Singh and Harvinder Singh could not be apprehended by the police as such their names have been kept in column No.2 in the report of under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C. Arrest warrants had been obtained against Wazir Singh and Harvinder Singh for 10.08.2015.

It has been informed that further steps are being taken to seek warrants of arrest qua the persons who have not been arrested. So far as accused Gurvinder Singh is concerned, he was not found at the spot and his name has been kept in column No.2 in the final report.

It has been informed that accused Kamaljit Singh and Joginder Singh have been arrested in the present case. Challan stands already presented before the Court of competent jurisdiction. On account of Wazir Singh and Harvinder Singh having not been arrested, necessary steps will be taken to get them arrested and present supplementary challan against them.

In view of above said circumstances, this petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous at this stage. However, a direction is issued to Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar Mohali for supervising the action being taken against accused Wazir Singh and Harvinder Singh and to seek report fortnightly qua them, expecting that in case there is sufficient material against them, supplementary challan against them after making sincere efforts for their arrest.
