**JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 268 dated June 08, 2010 under Sections 307, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.5, Civil Line, Ludhiana City and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2 Report of learned trial Court has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that the matter has been compromised between the parties with the intervention of respectable and well wishers. Complainant made his statement voluntarily without any pressure, coercion or any inducement, threat, or promised. He has made the statement with his own free will and submits that he has no objection in case the above-said FIR be quashed by this Court. The same is

genuine one. Even otherwise, matter involved in these proceedings is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. So, in view of circumstances narrated above as well as the observations made in case reported as *Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another (2014) 6 SCC 466*, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for the benefit of the parties and would certainly bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 268 dated June 08, 2010 under Sections 307, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.5, Civil Line, Ludhiana City and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same are quashed qua the petitioners.
