Main case

The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 105 dated 3.8.2008 registered under Sections 406, 498-A, 323, IPC at Police Station, Ajitwal, District Moga.

It is contended that the dispute had arisen out of a marital discord which has now been settled and the petitioner is in custody since November, 2014. These facts are not controverted by the learned counsel for the complainant who states unequivocally that the matter stands resolved between the petitioner and the complainant.

If that be so then instant petition is accepted. It is directed that the petitioner be released on bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.P.C. Bail to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court.

Nothing said herein shall be construed to be an expression on the merits of the case.
