The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for the issuance of directions to respondents no.2 and 3 for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

In so far as protection of life and liberty of the petitioner is concerned the averments and pleadings on record do not make any reference to a specific incident/instance on the basis of which any inference may be drawn as regards the apprehension of the petitioner as regards danger to her life and liberty being well founded.

Be that as it may, the instant petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent no.2 i.e. S.S.P., District Ferozepur as regards her grievance and apprehension, if any. In the eventuality of her doing so, respondent no.2 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit strictly in accordance with law.
