Since both these petitions are arising out of one and the same FIR, the same are being disposed of together.

The allegations against the petitioners are that petitioner Ajit Singh alleged to be owner of plot measuring 100 sq. yards sold the same to Rakesh petitioner on 8.3.2010 who subsequently on 11.3.2010 sold the same

very property to complainant Sumitra for Rs 11,75,000/- and in the agreement to sell they intentionally put a wrong date and has devised a plan inter se between themselves to sell the same very property on 7.10.2014 and thus fraudulently by this deception stripped the complainant of her valuable money though it is submitted on behalf of the petitioners by their counsel that a civil suit is pending between the parties and that it is a purely civil dispute and there is inordinate delay in registering the FIR.

Counsel for the petitioners finding that the Court was not inclined to grant bail, have made statement at this stage to withdraw both the petitions. Allowed to do so.

Both the petitions are dismissed as withdrawn.
