This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under sections 420, 406, 506 read with section 34 IPC at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar, vide FIR No.256 dated 24.6.2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is in custody since 4.7.2014. Case is triable by Magistrate, thus, no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer.

Bail has been opposed by learned State counsel as well as learned counsel representing the complainant on the ground that allegations against the petitioner are serious.

Heard.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the period of incarceration of the petitioner, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. The

trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial court.
