AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 7.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of a certificate (Annexure P-1) issued by the Additional District Registrar, Births and Deaths, Moga, wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 24.07.1993. Petitioner No.2 has also placed on record an extract of his Voter Identity Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 25.10.1992. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.

A copy of this order be given dasti to learned counsel for the petitioners on payment of usual charges.
