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MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for bail in terms thereof in case FIR No.35 dated 17.1.2015 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Palam Vihar, District Gurgaon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner had contended that the complaint is stated to be of 2013 and the FIR has been registered in the year 2015 at the behest of the co-accused. The property allegedly belonged to a developer a renowned company engaged in these activities and perusal of sale deed would indicate a recitation which may not be a normal corporate transaction.

Noticing the aforesaid, interim protection was granted to the petitioner on 30.3.2015 subject to his complying with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C., pursuant to which he has joined the investigation which fact is not controverted by the learned counsel for the State.

Having regard to the aforesaid, the interim directions dated 30.3.2015 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition allowed.
