Petitioner seeks direction to respondents No.1 to 4 for protection of his life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No. 5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that apprehending danger to his life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No. 5 and 6, petitioner approached the Superintendent of Police, Ambala-respondent No.3 by way of self contained representation dated 4.3.2015 ( Annexure P-4), but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.3 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate action, within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, the Superintendent of Police, Ambala-respondent No.3 is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioner, raised vide his representation dated 4.3.2015 (Annexure P-4) and take an appropriate action thereon at an early date, by passing an appropriate order, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
