Gurdeep Singh son of late S. Karnail Singh has applied for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 914 dated 09.10.2013 under Sections 420/467/468/471 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar.

The allegations in the FIR are that the petitioner in connivance with others forged the signatures of a Judicial Magistrate. In the inquiry report, Gurmeet Singh co-accused moved an application for grant of anticipatory bail which was dismissed by this court vide order dated 29.05.2014 passed in CRM No. M-19192 of 2014.

The grant of anticipatory bail, at this stage, shall hamper the investigation. So, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.
