This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR. According to learned counsel for the petitioners, matter has been settled between the parties. Thus, FIR deserves to be quashed.

Reply by way of affidavit of Harjinder Singh Gill, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police Khanna, Sub Division Khanna, Policed District Khanna, District Ludhiana, Punjab, has been filed in court today. Same is taken on record. According to same, investigation in the matter is still pending.

Allegation against the petitioners is that they entered into an agreement to sell dated May 25, 2010 and took ₹ 1 lac as earnest money. It later transpired that they were not owners of the entire land.

As the matter is still under investigation, this court does not intend to express any opinion on the merits of the case. It is well settled that at the stage of investigation, this court normally would not interfere to quash the FIR in its inherent jurisdiction. Dismissed.
