This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

Mr. R.S. Athwal, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant-respondent No.2. He has denied the factum of compromise.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kamaljeet Singh submits that the petitioner never appeared before the investigating agency. He was ultimately declared proclaimed offender on June 10, 2015.

In view of the above, the present petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise is misconceived and is dismissed as such.
