1. ***Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?***

Prayer made in this petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.459 dated 29.08.2014, under Sections 148/149/323/302/195A/34 IPC and Sections 25/25(54)/59 of Arms Act, P.S. Sadar Palwal, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that out of many people more than ten in number Ajay @ Rambir fired a gun shot, hitting Lala. Due to this injury Lala fell down and thereafter Nitu @ Ranvir and Lalit are also alleged to have fired upon Lala in a fallen condition. Others are alleged to have inflicted *Kulhari* and *Danda*

blows.

According to learned counsel for the petitioner name of the petitioner is not forthcoming in terms of inflicting injuries to Lala. During course of investigation it has been brought out that petitioner gave *Danda* blow on the deceased. In the post-mortem report the cause of death is stated to be due to shock and fire arm injury over chest and abdomen.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 29.08.2014. The case is for consideration of an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the merits of the case at this stage, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Palwal.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
