MAHESH GROVER, J.

Contends that he is willing to submit himself to the
process of law.

This court notices that on an earlier occasion the
petitioner was on bail but he abused the concession by not
appearing before the learned trial court resulting in the present
proceedings against him. The benefit of equitable relief can be
given to a person who has respect for law. The petitioner's
absence would reveal that he has not respected the law at all. In
any eventuality, since he has shown an inclination to abide by
law, the court would grant him another opportunity to appear
before the learned trial court on 24.3.2015. In case he does so and
make a prayer for regular bail, the same shall be considered by
the court of competent court and it shall dispose of the same in

accordance with law as expeditiously as possible but not later than three days from the date of moving such application.

Petition stands disposed of.
