Petitioner has sought a direction for free and fair investigation pursuant to FIR No. 44 dated 14.3.2013 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station, Lalru, District Mohali.

It appears that investigation was conducted in the matter and cancellation report was submitted. However, trial court directed re-investigation into the matter.

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that pursuant to order passed by the trial court, re-investigation was undertaken. Same is complete and cancellation report has again been prepared. Same shall be submitted before the competent court within one month.

In view of stand taken by the State, no further direction is necessary. Petitioner shall, however, be at liberty to avail the remedy available under the law. Disposed of.
