ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.81 dated 17.07.2014, registered under Sections 394, 413 IPC, Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per the allegations two persons had come on the motorcycle and had snatched the bag containing ornaments and the complainant has been examined in the Court and has identified those persons and the petitioner was named by the co-accused and he was not present on the spot. Learned counsel further states that the petitioner is on bail in all the cases registered against him.

Learned State counsel, after going through the record presented by the Investigating Officer, states that in all other five cases registered under Section 379/411 IPC, the petitioner is on bail.

The complainant has been examined. There is no other eye-witness. The trial will take long time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
