This petition has been filed by petitioner Paramjit alias Pappi for grant of regular bail.

As per the prosecution allegations, the petitioner has caused a datar blow below the right hip of complainant-injured Jagjit Kumar. He along with his co-accused has been booked for the offences punishable under sections 323, 324, 326 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner pleaded that the grievous injuries, caused to complainant Jagir Kumar, is not attributed to the petitioner. Only simple injury is attributed to him. He is in custody since 28.9.2014. The trial is going at a very slow pace, which will take time.

Learned State counsel has opposed the bail of the petitioner on the plea that his co-accused is already absconding and the petitioner has shared the common intention with him.

I have duly considered the aforesaid contentions.

Admittedly, the petitioner has caused a datar blow below the right hip of the complainant Jagjit Kumar. The said injury has been declared to be simple in nature. The grievous injury suffered by Jagjit Kumar is attributed to co-accused Jaims Masih who is at large. The petitioner is in custody for the last about six months. Only the statement of the doctor has been recorded so far. Thus, the conclusion of the trial will take time.

Thus, without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed. Petitioner Paramjit alis Pappi is ordered to be released on bail during the pendency of the case on furnishing the personal bond with surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
