This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.133 dated 11.7.2013 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Muktsar City, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Raj Singh states that there are two more FIRs against the petitioner. He further submits that the official present is not able to assist him properly with

regard to FIR No.5 dated 10.01.2014 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is on bail in FIR No.5 dated 10.01.2014 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur.

In the instant case the petitioner is in custody from 20.09.2014. Only one witness has been examined so far out of 21 witnesses. The trial is being held by the Court of Magistrate.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the fact that the trial will take time in conclusion, the instant petition is allowed and petitioner-Pritpal Singh be admitted to bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
